The Center is pleased to present the 34th annual Denver PrideFest, a **two-day festival** attended by **over 250,000 guests**, to be held **June 27 & 28, 2009** in Civic Center Park. PrideFest is produced by The GLBT Community Center of Colorado, an organization that has been the cornerstone of the GLBT Community in the Rocky Mountain region since 1976. PrideFest is **the largest GLBT pride celebration between LA and Chicago**, and draws guests from all over the Rocky Mountain region and the US.

Saturday, June 27 - Family Field Day and PrideFest Celebration

11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. - Downtown Civic Center Park

Festival attendees are welcome to enjoy activities and entertainment for kids, adults and pets; browse health and wellness booths, the family interactive area, youth alley, retail and commercial booths, and recharge at food and beverage stands while watching the famous Dogs in Drag Parade. Enjoy a full day of entertainment at 4 stages; **main stage, community stage, Latino stage, and dance stage**. We will also be holding our third annual kids' parade.

Sunday, June 28 - PrideFest Parade and Celebration

10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. - Cheesman Park and Downtown Civic Center Park

The traditional PrideFest parade starts at Cheesman Park and travels down Colfax Avenue to downtown Civic Center Park where our 250,000+ attendees (**estimated 75,000 - 100,000 attendees for the parade**), enjoy live entertainment on four stages; stroll through 240 booths, including sponsor row, health and wellness, retail and commercial booths; play in the family interactive area and visit the 40 food and beverage stands while enjoying local and national talent on the Main Stage. Sponsors and VIP's will also enjoy the hospitality of the VIP area.

Our main stage has grown over the years from a small showcase of local talent to a major event element featuring renowned national and regional acts. Over the past years we've welcomed CeCe Penniston, Tiffany, Sophie B. Hawkins and even Martha Wash. Fully programmed both days of the festival, it hosts the best of local talent and provides entertainment for thousands of guests all weekend. Sound is professionally run and designed, state-of-the-art, and carefully engineered. Our typical 24x24 ft. outdoor amphitheatre staging can be modified each year based on the requirements of our performing artists.
